Reports:

The email addresses of the schedulers has been placed on the website and will be on schedules that are issued. Members will follow the same process to alert the scheduler of any change.

No rating games will be scheduled.

After the weekly schedules are completed, a copy will be forwarded to Joe McClusky at the clubhouse.

Monica Strauss: We have decided that inasmuch as we will not be having any tennis events due to social distancing (Round Robins, Pizza Tennis, etc) the membership fee will be waived for this season. The yearly Autism Charity function is up-in-the air at this time.

All residents participating in tennis, golf, bocce, etc. must sign and have witnessed a Waiver. A white sheet for residents and a pink sheet for guests must be submitted to Management.

Claude and Raul have been made aware of this requirement. Dennis Lafer has advised Marcia to hold off sending this advisory to the tennis members.

Dennis Lafer called Marcia to discuss redoing the courts plus the possibility of using one of the courts for Pickle Ball.

The term of three Board members (Marcia Weinberg, Albie Shapiro and Helene Kleinwaks) are expiring this year. Albie and Helene have agreed to run again. Marcia will step down. Sometime in August, we will canvas the membership for volunteers to run for the Board.
